Everyone is invited to come out and help the CES cheerleaders and students rally around our spring athletes.

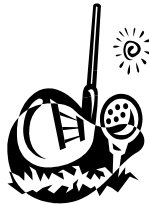




Coach Wiser is preparing the tracksters for their first track meet on Monday, April 17 at Strake Jesuit beginning at 4pm. This large group of middle school students has

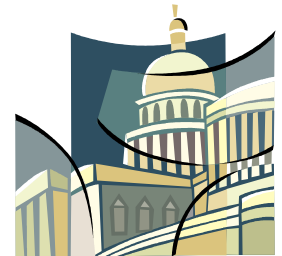
