## **CES Students Receive Duke University Talent Identification Program (TIP) State Recognition**

Students in fifth and seventh grade are selected for the Duke University TIP program based on their Stanford Achievement Test scores. This year, fifteen of our seventh graders qualified for this select program, which allows those who qualify to take the college entrance exams, SAT or ACT. Eleven of our seventh graders took the SAT and three of those eleven scored high enough to receive state recognition. **Phillip Bartholomew, Denys Herfort, and Lauren Mitchell** scored in the top twenty-five percent of those in the Talent Search pool. To qualify, students had to score at or above 510 on the math and/or verbal sections or a combination of 500 on both. These student scholars will be recognized at a special ceremony at Texas A&M on May 19.
