discuss with your child what your preference is for them at Holy Communion. The All-School Eucharistic Celebration begins at 8:05 in the Sanctuary.

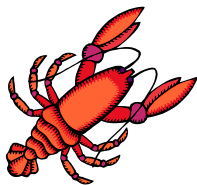
**PSIA Winners and PSIA Meeting**
