Citing an Online Image

When citing an online image from the internet, use the following instructions to create a properly formatted citation on your "Images Cited" page:

1. Image creator's last name, first name, ***if available***, or page author's name ***if available***, followed by a period.
2. Title of photo followed by a period, in quotation marks. If there is no title, briefly describe the image and place quotation marks around the description.
3. Descriptive word (photo, map, cartoon, drawing, etc,) followed by a period.
4. Website title in italics, followed by a period and a space. This is not the address but the title at the top of the website.
5. Website publication date, ***if available***, in DD Mo YYYY format followed by a period.
6. Date image was viewed/retrieved in DD Mo YYYY format followed by a period.
7. Web address in angle brackets, followed by a period.
