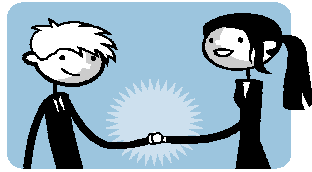

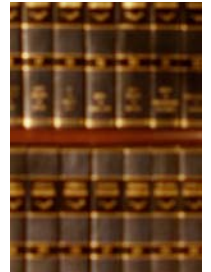
### World Book Online
