### Prospective Students' Open Houses

In the past two years CES enrollment has grown from 228



students to 258 students. This is quite a tribute to the reputation of the faculty, staff, parents and certainly the students themselves. At the time we are growing 13%, while other private schools are decreasing enrollment, or worse, closing. With a continuation of this type of growth, CES will be at 300 students in another two years, and approaching capacity. The quality of our students at Calvary remains high, as well. Our students score in the top ten percent of the nation on their yearly achievement tests, and over seventy percent of our seventh graders qualify for the Duke University Talent Identification Program.

All this said, anyone interested in joining the CES experience for the

2004-2005 school year is invited to one of our Prospective Student Open Houses. The first Open House will be held January 29 at 7pm.
