Service Projects at CES

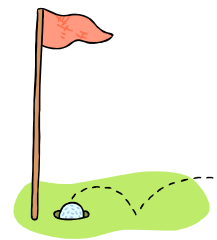
The CES National Junior Honor Society students are coordinating two service projects. "Shoes for Honduras" is a joint project with

Cell Phones are being collected for the Women's Center. Any cell phones may be sent to Ms. Haley's class and will be used by residents of the Women's Center as part of their program.

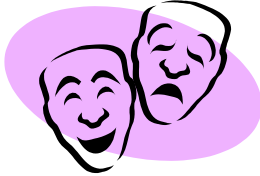
Golf Outing for UH Scholarships
