Stock Market Game Final Results

CES fielded eight teams of sixth grade graders in the Houston Chronicle Stock Market Game. Our teams competed with 256 other teams from across the region. Our top team of **Trevor Adair, Kristin Barnes** and **Bridgette Giammarco**



placed 16th out of the 256 teams, which included high schools! This is our finest showing ever in this game. Each team starts out with \$100,000 in the portfolio. Five of our eight teams finished with \$95,000 or more; three of eight teams gained over the initial \$100,000. Each participant will get a certificate at final chapel and the 16th place team members will be honored at an upcoming chapel.

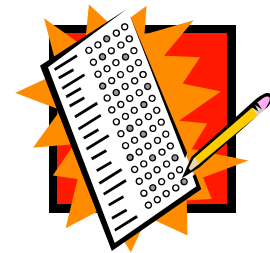
