## National Teacher Appreciation Week!

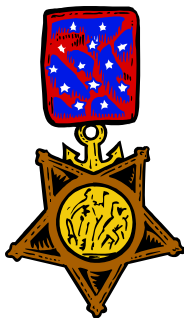
May 3-7 is **National Teacher Appreciation Week**. Our CPTO
