Did you know... That CES participates in the Duke University Talent Identification Program (TIP) each year? This program recognizes students throughout the nation who qualify as a select group eligible for a number of benefits, including the opportunity to take the college entrance exams, SAT or ACT, in the seventh grade. Students qualify by scoring in the top **five percent** of the nation on selected sections of an approved achievement test. (At CES, students take the Stanford Achievement Test each spring.) The seventh graders recognized by the Duke University Talent Identification Program (TIP) this year are: **Micaela Aguirre, Jared Beale, John Brunkhorst, Harrison Frehe, Evan Hutchinson, Justin Jones, Rose Worley, Gregg Lamb, Abby Mangel, Dan Pepin, Zvoni Smith and Erik Wiedenfeld.** These students represent **40% of the 6th grade class** who took the Stanford Achievement Test last year and qualified for the TIP!
