



## HELP YOUR CHILD BECOME A GUARDIAN PIRATE READER! Sponsored by the library

We are excited about the Pirate Reader Incentive Program for grades pre-k and kindergarten. The goal of this library program is to encourage you to read to your children and help your children develop advanced vocabulary words and language. There are so many educational benefits of bonding to your child with language.

A reading log will be sent home with each child and should be maintained and updated by a parent. Once the target of 20 books has been met, the log should be returned to the school library and a new sheet will be given. Your child will be rewarded with a Guardian Pirate Reader charm and a prize. Pirate chains will be worn during library time. There will be 10 logs in all. When your child completes Level 10 a Pirate t-shirt will be awarded, and in May all students who reach Level 10 will be invited to an ice cream party.

*No more than one completed log sheet will be accepted each week.*

Please help your child to complete the ten sheets. Your goal will be approximately one sheet per month. Any books can be used, including books from your home library, the public library, or the Calvary library. A book may be read more than once if it is your child's favorite.
