Book Title = Paul Revere Patriot and Craftsman
Publishing City and State = Mankato, Minnesota
Publisher = Creative Education
Copyright Date = 1974
Print or Web = Print

Example of Encyclopedia Source:

Leon, Miguel A. "Peru." *The World Book Encyclopedia*. 2008 ed. Print.

Author = Leon, Miguel A.
Article Name – Peru
Encyclopedia Name = The World Book Encyclopedia
Copyright edition = 2008 ed.
Print or Web = Print

- **Always use Times Roman 12 pt. font.**
- **Do not add any large fonts, styles, or bolding to your paper.**
- **Double space all research papers including the Works Cited page. Do not use extra spaces anywhere.**
- **Alphabetize your citation entries by the first letter of each line.**
- **Indent second and third lines of each citation if they are longer than one line.**
