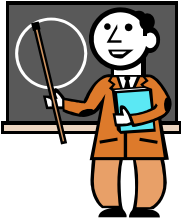
**Remember School Zone**

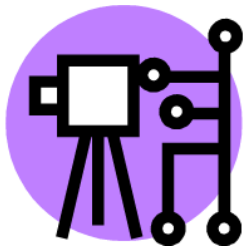


### **Lost and Found**
